## What is Academic Adventure?

In its sixth year, Enatai Eagle Academic Adventure (EEAA) is refreshed and expanded to encourage kids to experience many of the PTSA-sponsored activities that are available to every Enatai student. For each adventure they complete, students earn a limited-edition, collectible sticker to save in this keepsake album. Kids who collect multiple stickers are eligible for awards at the end of the school year.

## Who can participate and why do they do it?

EEAA is open to all Enatai students at no cost, thanks to the generous donations to PTSA from families like yours. Kids get a chance to try things they might not normally, set goals and stick with them throughout the year to earn awards.

## How do I participate?

To participate in Academic Adventure, save this packet to collect limited edition stickers at events throughout the year. Try to collect as many as you can to help you remember the fun you had in 2019-20!

Students who wish to be recognized at the Awards Assembly should register at <http://enataiptsa.org/Page/Activities/AcademicAdventure>. You'll also get email updates throughout the year. The more you participate, the higher the level of award you'll earn. At the year end Awards Assembly in June, three levels of awards will be recognized:

- ✓ Complete 4 adventures – earn the Strutting Eagle Award
- ✓ Complete 7 adventures – earn the Strutting Eagle + Adventurous Eagle
- ✓ Complete 13 or more adventures – earn the Strutting Eagle + Adventurous Eagle + the Principal's Award

Submit a final entry form by **May 15** to be eligible for the Awards Assembly. Final entry forms will be available online starting in March.

**Get Started!** To get started, your album includes a sticker for attending an Assembly and for the Literacy Adventure. As soon as you attend an Assembly and finish the Literacy requirement for your grade, you'll be halfway to the Strutting Eagle Award!

# Create your very own **2019-2020 Enatai Eagle Academic Adventure!**

Pick something you want to improve this year and “stick with it” to earn a one-of-a-kind sticker that you design.

Pick at least one thing that you would like to learn about, to try, or to improve this school year. Set your goals with a trusted adult and work on it for at least twelve weeks.

You could choose something like:

- Improve at an afterschool activity
- Get better at math
- Improve reading levels
- Improve time on the pacer test in PE
- Play a musical instrument or sing
- Be an even more thoughtful person
- Learn how to cook more things
- Draw/paint/write/dance/make a movie
- Recycle more, do chores without being told, volunteer
- Plus many, many more of your very own ideas!

## Adventure Timeline

**Now:** Start thinking about what you want to do/try/learn this year

**Anytime between now and January 27:** Start your own adventure by no later than January 27. This will give you at least 12 weeks to improve and still have time to design your sticker.

**Starting January 6:** Create-your-own sticker instructions will be available at the Academic Adventure Kiosk by the STEM room and online at [enataiptsa.org](http://enataiptsa.org).

**May 15:** Last day to turn in your sticker design to the Office

**June Awards Assembly:** Your custom printed sticker will be delivered to your classroom.

## Choose Your Own Adventure

- Work on your adventure at least once per week for at least twelve weeks
- Receive instructions in January for how to create your sticker
- Submit your sticker by May 15
